TAMWORTH CONSERVATION COMMISSION - March 20, 1989

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.
2. Members and officers. Peg and Betty have been re-appointed by the Selectmen. Election of Officers. It was moved by Peter, seconded by Lori, and affirmed by vote to re-elect the present officers: Peg King, Chairman and Corresponding Secretary, Betty Steele, Vice-chairman and Recording Secretary, Dana Steele, Treasurer.
3. Jackman-North Bridge. Needs posts, 2x6's and planking. Harold will get the lumber to the bridge site while there is still thick ice on the pond, although the work cannot be done until later. Chocorua Valley Lumber donated wood for walkway. Dana is away, not expected to return until mid-April.
4. Tin Mt. Conservation Center. Peg reported the Commission members are invited to a thank you reception and party on Thursday, March 30th, 7:00 p.m. at Red Jacket Mt. View Inn. Peg will check with Town treasurer to see if the center has been paid the \$100 we agreed to pay, and if not will ask the Treasurer to pay it. (It probably has been done, but Dana is not here to report on it).
5. Hemenway Permit - Peg has requested DRED to start renewal proceedings, which takes some time. The permit runs out at the end of this year.
6. Household Hazardous Waste. Peg checked several concerns for price of leaflet which was given out at time of voting, March 14th. Lowest was Mary Anne Gotschall, who mimeographed it, and at very short notice, too. Peg, with help from Isabel Hoag gave them out on the 14th. Agreed we need considerable information from Lakes Region Planning well before June 10th - especially as to publicity they will do, and brochures they will furnish. Lori suggested a sign at the dump, to face in both directions, and to be put up around May 10. Chris agreed to supply the sign. It was also agreed we should try to have something in local column in paper to supplement publicity done by Lake Region Planning.
7. Letter to Planning Board re information to be sought from applicants. A draft of this, written by Peter, was distributed, to be discussed at next meeting.
8. Great Hill Tower - peg will talk with Harry Remick to get repairs done and also to paint out graffiti on inside of tower - using matching paint so entire inside doesn't have to be painted.
9. Carroll County Conservation District - Annual Meeting. April 13, 6 p.m., Lobster Trap, Westside Road, North Conway, subject - N. H. Wetlands Board Permit Application.
10. State Law allowing land use change tax to be voted into Conservation Fund - agreed this couldn't have been done this year with heavy tax increase, but to keep in tickler file for future reference.
11. Easements. John asked for a list of easements in town, for Tamworth Land Protection Committee use, in finding possible matching donations.
12. Bookholz Revised Application was sent the Commission from Phillips Engineering. It took into consideration the suggestions made by Peter in the Commission's letter on the original application. Peter has a few comments re wetlands on the revised plan, and was authorized to draft a letter for Peg to send to Wetlands Board.
13. Planning Board member of Conservation Commission. It was agreed to ask the Planning Board to appoint one.
