Tamworth Conservation Commission Meeting - July 12, 1993

PRESENT: John Mersfelder, Lori Gerard, Chris Conrod, Ned Beecher, Peg King,

1. Minutes of previous meeting approved.
2. Dredge and Fill - Bridge - Urquhart, Wonalancet. Chris has checked this with Bill Read who is doing the work, and sees no problem with it. It is a replacement of an old bridge, but higher, and will have new abutments and span. Chris, however, has suggested erosion and siltation control while work is being done. Old abutments were in stream bed, but new ones will not be, which is an advantage.
3. Dredge and Fill - Dock, Chocorua Lake, Linda Nighswander. John gave to all members present a copy of a letter to Allan Smith, president of Chocorua Lake Conservation Foundation; this letter is part of these minutes. Copies of the letter went to the Selectmen, Linda Nighswander, and Damon Newsom-president of Chocorua Lake Association. TCC will watch the progress of this.
4. Dredge and Fill, minimum impact, Tom Cleveland, near junction of Brown Hill and Cleveland Hill Road was reported.
5. Fund Raising for Tin Mt. program at Brett School. John reported receipts of \$375 to date. It was requested that each TCC member send to John a list of all those already solicited or to be solicited, so there will be a master list for future reference. Ned reported that Tin Mt. had suggested a project for an observation and drawing teacher in conjunction with this project, at a cost of \$1000, of which Tin Mt. would pay half. Arts Council of Tamworth has been asked for a grant of \$500, and it appeared that the Arts Council might do fund raising for this. This could be awkward for both Tin Mt. and TCC if there was separate fund raising for one project, especially if the same people were contacted by both organizations. Ned will talk with the Arts Council to coordinate their fund raising with that of TCC. As this is to be for all of SAU 13, perhaps the Council fund raising could be for other towns than Tamworth.
6. Septic, request for waiver. David Cluff, representing John Roberts for the project which is in Chocorua Meadows, came to the meeting at the request of the Selectmen. Chris will look at the area this week with Mr. Cluff. It was agreed that if the chairman feels a waiver should be given he will attend the public hearing held by the Planning Board.
