Meeting - September 13, 1993

1. Minutes of the previous meeting approved with the following exceptions:
#2 - Last sentence of 3rd paragraph, delete "remove the fill and"
#5 - The Town, not John, sent a copy of insurance coverage to Lindsays
#7 - John will contact Hank LeTarte, not Ron Remick
2. Eric Anderson, Eagle Scout project. Eric came to this part of the meeting to explain his project. He is in the 10th grade at Moultonboro Academy. Is planning to outline three projects which he might undertake this fall with help from other scouts, working on weekends. He is meeting with Cam Greene in two days, to discuss these. They will be submitted to a Scout committee for approval, and then he will choose one. First suggestion to him was work on a trail from Jackman Pond to the Bearcamp River - coordinate location with Community School, get School and TCC approval for plans (a tentative route has been marked out), map layout, flag it, clear, mark, sign, write description, and publicize. Altho this is a TCC project, it is possible the Community School has already done it. In that case a Big Pines project was suggested - to restore the Easy Walkers Trail, write a brochure for nature Trail, and other work at Big Pines. John will call Martha Carlson, and Cam Greene about this. Eric's address is P O Box 142, Tamworth, tel. 323-9448.
3. Dredge and Fill violation - Skandia North, opposite entrance to White Lake. Planning Board hasn't heard from them since it sent them materials, so matter hasn't been resolved.

VOTE I - That after a double check with Planning Board that Skandia has done nothing to resolve the issue, that TCC report the violation to the Wetlands Board. (Moved by Chris, seconded by Lori, and passed.)

Agreed to tell Skandia TCC needs to take picture, and that TCC will get more information to include in report to Wetlands Board.

4. Dredge and Fill - Nighswander Dock. John reported the Chocorua Lake Conservation Foundation is handling this internally by giving legal information as to State regulations to all who might build docks.
5. Complaint on possible erosion to stream, from road building near Bruce Bolles, as reported by Peter Smart. Bolles plans on bank stabilization with loam. It is thought this is a Class VI town road which was never discontinued. Agreed to go to Selectmen and let them know that preventive action is needed. There is no violation as yet.
6. Reported blockage of Bearcamp, across from Guy Grace's, where a tree has fallen into the river. Grace is afraid it can cause flooding. No permit is needed to remove it. Lori will look at it, and let John know if there is anything TCC can do, perhaps remove the tree.
7. Wetlands Applications - John reported the following: Mersfelder, minimum impact has been approved; Duck Pond application of 1992 - Betty will check to see if any more work has been done there and report to John; Stoney Brook on Gilman Valley Road - Wetlands Board has approved with recommendations.

8. Education - Tin Mt. program. Lori reported donations of \$1515 to date. Program has started - Peg will visit to see now it is working.
9. Wetlands Regulations - Peter Cooperdock and Harold Cook haven't turned in their copies. They will be asked again. John had bought three more copies - he, Ned and Lori each took one and will put a binder on it.
10. TCC Membership. When John asked Hank LeTarte about serving he found Hank was not a resident of Tamworth. It was felt Hank would be a good member of the Commission; however, after some discussion, it was decided it would be inappropriate to ask a non-resident to serve. Therefore John will now ask Ron Remick.
11. N. H. Assoc. of Conservation Commission Annual Meeting is Saturday, Nov. 6th. At TCC's next meeting members should let John know if they can go.
12. Big Pines - trail clearing. Agreed to do it Sunday, Sept. 26th, meeting at trailhead at 8:30 a.m. Betty had walked the trail except for the steep part of Spur Trail that morning and had written a report on what appeared to be needed. She added bridge should be checked - preservatives?
13. Easement Signs. Chris will try to ask landowners before next meeting so signs can be ordered. Owners are Dick Alt, Bob Freeto, Percy Olton and Betsey Loughron (former Irwin easement). Peg will ask Betsey.
