MEETING - February 14, 1994

PRESENT: John Mersfelder, Loralie Gerard, Chris Conrod, Peg King, Betty Steele

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved, with two corrections. The date was January 11, 1994. Ned and John's report on meeting with the School Board re funding for the Tin Mt. third grade program was omitted; it is expected Ned will make this report at the March meeting.

VOTE I, moved by Chris, seconded by Lori.

2. Easement - signs. Wording of sign for Scott Aspinall has been worked out. He wants an oval emblem on the sign, which he will put on, TCC to allow for this in placement of the lettering. He agreed to be responsible for upkeep of sign. A title is needed for the sign on the Community School easement.

Agreed to check sign on Waterfowl Haven in Chocorua after snow is gone; this is TCC owned land.

3. Easement - Eric Anderson project- he has requested to meet with Commission to work out details. Chris will try to outline the project and John will talk with him. It was felt it was unnecessary for Eric to meet with the full commission.
4. Violation - Skandia North. The Wetlands Board has acknowledged receipt of TCC report made by Chris. Skandia North has made an application, but lacking much information the Wetlands Board needs to act on it.
5. Beaver Dam Removal. Peg has a copy of the RSA concerning this which she will copy and bring to the next meeting, so each member will have it.
6. Lilacs - U.N.H. Cooperative Extension. Peter Pohl has written to offer TCC free lilacs, 4' - 6', light purple; trees to be dug and picked up at Carroll County Farm complex, probably with some help from personnel there. Needs an answer by March 18th. Trees are only for Town owned property. The following were suggested:

School - Peg will talk with Mr. Simone

Near Mill Brook Bridge, Rte. 113 - John will check with Selectmen

Town Park - John will talk with Joan Casarotto

Cemeteries - John will check with Harold Cook, Trustee of
Trust Funds

It was hoped the Town could supply a back hoe to dig the holds - John will check this with Selectmen.

At March meeting it will be decided how many lilacs are needed.

7. GIS mapping. Rick Elsmore of Soil Conservation Service wants to make a presentation to the Commission, and to have a Planning Board member present. This will be set up for the April 11th meeting. Although there was some difference of opinion as to the value of this to TCC it was agreed to listen to the presentation.
