Meeting - March 14, 1994

Present: John Mersfelder, Chris Conrod, Lori Gerard, Peg King, Betty Steele

1. Minutes of previous meeting were approved.
2. Easement Signs. Ned brought two signs - for Aspinall and Perkins Community School easements. Cost was \$200 and a check will be sent to Sheldon Perry. Ned has the logo that Scott requested for the Aspinall easement and will work out with Scott how to put logo on sign and where sign should be placed. Signs should be hung, or if backing put on, and allowance made for wood to move, they could be on posts. Ned will show one of signs to Dick Alt to see what he wants on his easement.
3. Dredge and Fill - Minimum impact. John reported two applications - from Karl Smith, # 207 on tax map, and from Dennis Oddo, #217 on tax map.
4. U.N.H. Cooperative Extension - offer of lilacs. Brett School could use 10 and Tamworth Library could use two. Harold Cook said cemeteries could use any number of lilacs. It was decided to ask for 3 dozen. It is hope to have a work day for planting these, a town work day.

Kate Thompson has asked again about planting Chinese elms. But TCC needs to know more about them, as to salt resistance, etc. John will consult with Extension Service about this.
5. Conservation Camp. There is a possibility the Garden Club may not offer a scholarship this year. The brochure: **about the camp** seemed to imply it was only for high school graduates, but the wording was not clear. Peg will call to clarify this so it can be discussed at next meeting. Date for registration is sometime in May.
6. Wetlands Board has published a booklet. "Wetlands Protection", a group effort by conservation organizations. John will order copies for other members of the Commission.
7. Planning Board Survey - summary of results. TCC was well rated; however quite a number of people had no opinion, indicating TCC work is not well known. It was agreed TCC members who did not already have copies of this summary should get them, study the report before the next meeting, so it could be discussed. Chris indicated TCC would be asked to write the Conservation section of the Master Plan. Lori will get extra copies tomorrow and leave them in the TCC basket file in the inner room. There was discussion of means of publicizing TCC work - poster, press releases, public notice re household hazardous waste, publicity by regional conservation commissions, etc.
8. Eric Anderson - Chris has worked out an outline of trail work to be done. Copies were given out.
