Meeting - July 11, 1994

Present: John Mersfelder, Chris Conrod, Peg King, Betty Steele. Also Charles Townsend, Kevin Ash

1. Minutes of previous meeting approved.
2. Easements - Signs. Signs on Perkins and Aspinall easements are up. Dick Alt wants a sign; Chris will draft the wording.
VOTE I - To authorize up to \$150 for signs and posts for Alt easement.
(Moved by Betty, seconded by Peg- voted unanimous).
3. Easements on Land Conservation Investment Program (LCIP) lands. John reported the Perkins and Aspinall easements would be monitored by a committee. The Society for the Protection Of N. H. Forests has notified him that they will need some information for base documentation. John will check specifics of what is needed and let Chris know.
4. Easements - Eric Anderson cannot start work until August.
5. Easement documentation. Chris said that for each that had been completed there are three copies - one in the vault, one to owner and one to easement documentation chairman (Chris).
6. Wetlands - Lundberg violation, Skandia North. Wetlands Board told him to remove fill, which he has agreed to do, to seed area, take usual erosion controls, send Wetlands Board photos of completed work by October 15th.
7. Wetlands - violation on Route 113A, as reported item # 7 of last meeting, has not been checked as yet, but will be before August meeting.
8. Hemenway - lumbering near Spur Trail. John has talked with Bob Hardy. Only one skidder trail will be used, to run off the Blake Orchard Road to the Spur Trail, trail to be kept open throughout the work, which will be done in winter. Brush will be moved. Plans are for 20' strip cuts with 100' between each, and to work towards two deeryards. Work will be monitored regularly.
9. Household Hazardous Waste. John had a cupply of posters and brochures. Peg will take material to stores and Chris will take it to dump, along with the sign. Peg will try to get Charlotte Cooper and Barbara Nordeen to help on the collection day, July 30th.
10. Hemenway - Bridge. Painting on a preservative will be done August 27th, and trail work may be done then too. Chris will get cuprinol - John will measure bridge and let Shris know. Peg will put notice in paper asking to volunteers and will suggest a call to John to let him know who might be coming.
11. Membership in TCC. John said Selectmen would like to talk with Charlie Townsend before appointing him, as they do not know him. John asked Charlie to come to Town Offices at 7:15 on July 21st.

Kevin Ash said he had lived in Tamworth six years, worked for White Mt. Survey and some for Independent Press. He is a draftsman, does field work and septic design.
