DRAFT MINUTES, - Meeting January 6, 1996

1. Minutes of December minutes approved with one change in item #3 - it is the Tamworth Civic Association.
2. Wetlands - Bemick Trust. John read a letter from Wetlands Board to Cluff designs, file # 951872, to say more information is needed on the application - delineation of wetland, dredge area, fee is \$340 based on square footage within wetlands, tax map, and list of abutters. This information could also be given to TCC, but we haven't received it as yet. John also read a letter from Peter Cooperdock to Bemick Trustees voicing Nancy Williams concerns. Trustees may decide to relocate septic. Also may decide to wait until spring and send in a new application.
3. Route 16 Study. TCC has received a copy of a letter from Lakes Region Planning to the Selectmen asking them to appoint two members and an alternate to the study group, this to be done by January 19th, and after consultation with Conservation Commission and Planning Board. In the discussion of this Chris suggested there should be someone from Chocorua in the group. Two possibilities are Sandra Beauchesne and Rick Canfield.
4. Members. John said no official resignation has been received from David Cluff, although he had called John and said he must resign as he was moving to Freedom. He said he would write, but hasn't done so as yet. It was felt TCC should have it in writing, in order to be definite about appointments.
5. Finance Committee will meet January 9, 22 and 23. Asked TCC to make appointment and bring to it 1994-1995 and 1995-1996 budget, equation/basis for requests, 1995 total spent, details of service, number of clients and other income. Lori and John will meet with them and request an appointment for January 22 at 8:15 or possibly later, as Lori may have a baby-sitting problem with her children.
6. Budget. Lori proposed a budget which was discussed and several changes made. Final budget was as follows: MAMCC Annual dues for 1997 - \$175; Tin Mt. donation - \$100; Annual meeting and/or any meetings, workshop, reg fees, etc. - \$80; phone bills - \$25; Postage \$50; Stationary \$100; Land protection \$100; and Trail maintenance \$150; This totals \$780. VOTE 1 - To accept the above proposal. Moved by Betty, seconded by Chris,
7. Great Hill Tower. It was agreed to check the need for a protective bar on the steps unless it was a simple thing TCC could take care of. Charlie will check the problem and let John know. John will discuss this with Selectmen if need be, as the Great Hill Tower budget is their concern - TCC only manages it. Also there's a possibility of carry over funds for Tower.
8. Tamworth Civic Association has offered TCC newsletter space, deadline Jan. 10. John read a letter he had drafted, which was approved.
