DRAFT MINUTES - MEETING June 9, 1997

PRESENT: John Mersfelder, Chris Conrod, Roy Ames, Kris Bontaites, Charlie Townsend, Marlene Ostrowski, Betty Steele

1. Minutes of the April meeting were approved, except in item # 11 Chris should be spelled **Kris**.
2. Members - Marlene **has** not yet been sworn in, but **will** be shortly.
3. Selectmen. John reported the Selectmen's problem with the Havelock easement **was** the proposed sub-division. It would have helped if TCC had had the **Selectmen's** thinking on: this sooner. The Selectmen had not yet discussed the proposal **for** a sludge **committee**, but would do so shortly. It **was agreed** to pursue this **with** a written request if necessary.
4. Alt easement on "Damon" lot. A set **back** of 400' for a building has been proposed. John has checked the lot, agreed with the proposal, and so informed **Jim Alt**, **who plans** to move here on a year-round basis.
5. Trails. Roy reported that he and Chris had cleared Jackman North. The bridge needs stringers, **but the planks** are all **right**.  

VOTE I - To authorize **Roy** to spend whatever is needed to **fix** the bridge. (Moved by Chris, seconded by **Kris**). **Passed**.
- Roy reported the **box** at Big Pines is O.K. There is **need** to work on a brochure for **Black Spruce Bogs**. John reported TCC now has a **permit** renewal for Big Pines to last to **December 31, 1998**.
6. **Aspinall** easement sign. Chris has talked with Scott, who **says** he will put up the sign, **back** somewhat from the road. He wants a **kiosk**, and **asked Chris** to make a roof **for** the sign. He **has** put **some** trails in and will put in more. **Kris** said there **was** a **deeryard** in there, which she hoped would not be disturbed.. She will bring the **deeryard** map for Tamworth to the next meeting.
7. Brochures. **Kris has** distributed **about** half of them. All do not need to go out **now**, as some will be needed for replenishing.
8. Household **hazardous** waste day - Saturday, July 26th. TCC will distribute fliers, **as soon as they are ready**; **it's** a bit late now **as** people are already beginning to **make** inquiries. **Chris** will put up the sign **at** the dump,
9. Bookcase - Selectmen have approved one in the entrance hall at the Town Office Building, for TCC library. **Kris's** father, Stan **Rines** will build it. It should **have** glass doors and a lock. TCC **asked** that **Kris** and Stan submit an estimate **at** the-July **meeting**.
10. Questionnaire from NHACC, **requesting** to know **what issues are** planned for **next** two years. Copies were **given** to each member - to be studied and discussed **at** the next meeting.
11. Dollars and Cents meeting, on Current **Use**. The meeting in Albany **was** cancelled without notice. There will be one in Dover on June **13th**. Marlene may go.
12. Conservation News Bulletin. **This** is only **sent** to chairmen. **Copies** were made and given to each member.

13. Route 16 Corridor study. John, who is the environmental representative on this study, reported that categories had been listed such as system maintenance, alternatives (railroad and intermodal), safety action and solutions, capacity, and action plan for corridor. There are 6 groups represented on the study committee and the committee was trying to find which group was interested in individual categories.
14. TCC plan - John asked each member to read Section 2, so it could be discussed at the July meeting.
