1. Minutes of the January meeting were approved, except that details of the \$835 budget should have been included. Herewith are those details:

2. Easements. Work on the Mabel Evans property is progressing. John is working with Ken Cargill on a draft easement.
3. Trails. John had written the director of DRED requesting a renewal of TCC's permit on Hemenway, and to include the trail to the Tower from the parking area on the west side. He received a reply from director of Land Management to say tho permit is renewed, and stating the use of the trail was included in the deed to the Town of the Tower, and was never in the permit.
4. Chocorua Post Office. The concern as to pollution from parking lot runoff is being pursued.
5. Forestry Minimum Impact - Kris report three - Bonneville, Cole and Wallace.
6. Transfer Station - possible site, John has visited the site.
7. Lakes Region Planning meeting re permanent site for household hazardous waste disposal - John attended this,
8. Biosolids. John reported weekly meetings the past month to prepare a health ordinance to be presented to the Selectmen for consideration, who could put it in place on their own authority. It basically accepts the state regulations, but with some tightening up,
9. N. H. Land and Community Heritage Commission wants TCC to sign a letter to the federal Senate and House budget committees urging full funding of Land and Water Conservation Commission, Historic Preservation Program, Forest Legacy Program, Farmland Protection Program, and payment in lieu of taxes for federally owned land in towns.

10. Land & Community Heritage Commission report - the N. H. legislature voted not to fund tho proposals and to defer final decision. Search is still being made for funding.
